## ***Executive Summary***

A Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) is a plan that provides guidance and lists actions taken to prevent contamination of stormwater. The SWPPP described herein has been developed so as to extend the current Multi Sector Generic Permit for Storm Water Discharge Associated with Industrial Activity (MSGP) for the Key West International Airport (KWIA) following state regulation governing storm water discharges from airport facilities. The MSGP permit is renewed every five years.

This report details the site specific activities and associated Best Management Practices (BMP) that are to be followed at Key West International Airport. Since much of the airport functions are carried out by the tenants of the airport, for the airport to be compliant with the state requirements, the attached forms with the appropriate site specific information requested are to be filled out by the tenants with oversight provided by the airport authority.

The attached record logs for SWPPP updates, employee training, and facility inspections provided in **Attachment E** and **Attachment F** are to be updated by the tenants annually as required by the conditions of the storm water permit for industrial activity.

Tenants are expected to implement the BMPs detailed in **Section 3** at their facility to ensure storm water pollution prevention, and compliance with this storm water permit.
